Schools & Programmes

Each school offers National Diploma (ND) and Higher National Diploma (HND) programmes accredited by the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE).

Admission Requirements

For National Diploma (ND) programmes, candidates must possess at least five (5) O'Level credit passes in relevant subjects, including English Language and Mathematics, obtained at not more than two sittings. Candidates must also sit for the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) and meet the institutional cut-off mark.

For Higher National Diploma (HND) programmes, applicants must hold a National Diploma in a relevant field with a minimum of Lower Credit, plus a minimum of one year post-ND industrial work experience, and satisfy the O'Level requirements stated above.

Fees & Funding

Tuition and other charges are reviewed periodically. The current fee schedule for the 2026/2027 session is provided in the Fees section of the admissions page. Limited scholarships and bursaries are available to outstanding students and indigenes of the host community.

Campus Life

Our campus offers modern lecture halls, well-equipped laboratories, a digital library, sporting facilities, hostels, and a vibrant Student Union Government. We encourage every student to participate in at least one co-curricular activity for holistic development.
